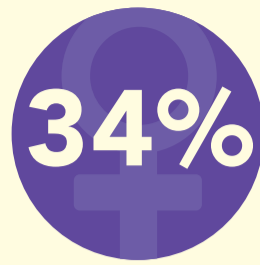

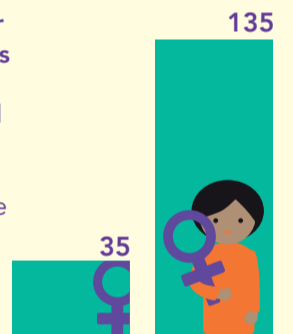

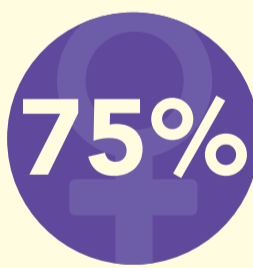
women in Sri Lanka went on to become entrepreneurs during the year, earning their own incomes.

Palestine

In Palestine, the number of female entrepreneurs in We Effect's partner organizations increased significantly, from 35 to 135 entrepreneurs. In addition, their average income was three times higher than expected.
